

# KIFF 10 HOUR FILM FESTIVAL:

Saturday, November 9th, 2019 8:30 A.M. - 6:30 P.M.

Screening at 7:45 P.M. and Awards at 10 P.M

- 100% of your film must be shot during the 10 hours of the competition.
- Prior to the competition, your team will draw a theme for your film, the theme will be one of the following words: art, truth, passion, community, diversity, dreams, hope, respect.
- Each team will be provided a local film industry professional as a team captain.
- All films must include the selected prop, word, and theme. Films that do not include those items will not win a prize.
- Submissions are all digital. The submissions should be on a jump drive. It is your responsibility to retrieve your jump drive. Format must be h264 or mpeg4. Please include at least 5 seconds of black leader.
- Audio needs to be recorded at a level between -4 and 0.
- KIFF will not be held responsible for loss of any materials, screening problems or judges' decisions.
- KIFF may choose to not screen or cease screening of any film at any time.
- Would you want your grandmother to watch this film?
- Films which expose persons or property to undue risk of injury or damage will not be accepted. Any screening will be halted and will automatically be disqualified from judging.
- KIFF will retain non-exclusive screening, promotional and reproduction rights to all entries.
- Time limit will be measured from the first sound, credit, image or scene to credits end. There is a 3 minute minimum film length. A time limit will be determined the morning of the event, based on the number of team entries.
- If in your opinion the film might get an 'R' rating from the mpaa let us know so we can alert the audience. Failure to notify KIFF of adult content will result in disqualification from the contest.
- Films need to be turned in by the announced time (I.E. Ten hours after dismissal) at the screening location. Under extraordinary conditions, the deadline may be extended at the sole discretion of the kiff board.
- Late films may still be screened, at the discretion of contest officials, but they will not be eligible for judging or awards/prizes. Late films may still be eligible for audience choice award.
- Please shoot your film in 16x9.
- There is no fee for participation, but there is a 10 dollar fee for entrance into the opening night awards ceremony, Saturday, November 9th, 10:00 P.M. at the Glenwood Arts Theatre.
